GA is transforming from an event at which one needs be present to experience into a hybrid meeting—incorporating off-site delegate participation, live-streaming of events, and social media to create an interactive experience for on-site and remote attendees.

Watching GA Video

Here's all you need to watch GA video on your computer or mobile device:

- A high-speed Internet connection. We recommend 1.5Mbps or greater download speed.
- Speakers or headphones. Live-streaming video will include the captions that are typed as the event occurs (which means there will be errors).
